Butterflies will visit your garden if you give them their favorite food sources, but they also need a few other essentials if you want them to make your garden their home.

Host Plants: plants for nesting, or for feeding while in the caterpillar stage

Water source: shallow water filled plate, or place a few large rocks in a bird bath to make shallow areas

Hiding Places: some species will use butterfly houses, others prefer unkempt areas where perennials are left standing over winter and butterflies will be undisturbed while in the egg, caterpillar or chrysalis stage.
