### HERBS AND THE FOODS THEY GO WITH

HERB	DESCRIPTION	GOOD IN:
BASIL	tastes of licorice and cloves At its best with tomatoes	pesto, soups, sauces, sandwiches, pizza salads
CHIVES	delicate onion or garlic flavor best used fresh	salads, dips, potatoes
CILANTRO	Pungent with undertones of anise Best uncooked Seed is coriander	salsa, fish, chicken, stews, soups
DILL	fresh sharp taste	dips, cottage cheese, eggs, potato salad, fish, cucumber dishes,
MARJORAM	similar to oregano but sweeter and more delicate	red meat and fish
MINT	aromatic with many undertones depending on variety.	Lamb dishes, teas and cold drinks, fruit salads, peas, carrots
OREGANO	greatest pungency when dried	pizza, tomato sauce, poultry, game, seafood or anything you wish to take in an Italian direction
PARSLEY - FLAT LEAF	most pungent, best for cooking very versatile	chop with garlic to use on roasted lamb grilled steak, fish, chicken or vegetables
PARSLEY - CURLY	mild flavor, more ornamental	salads, as garnish
ROSEMARY	lemon-pine flavor, aromatic, and pungent	lamb, poultry, pork, breads
SAGE	pungent, redolent of eucalyptus and cedar	stuffing, sausage, pork dishes, beans, poultry dishes
SUMMER SAVORY	similar to thyme in flavor preferred over winter savory for culinary use	chicken, mushrooms
WINTER SAVORY	similar to thyme, stronger in flavor than summer savory, ornamental	
TARRAGON	licorice flavor, strong, a little goes a long way	infused vinegar, fish, eggs, chicken, adds pizzazz to green salads
THYME	very versatile	Cajun & Creole dishes, lamb, pork, poultry, soups, sauces, stuffing
